

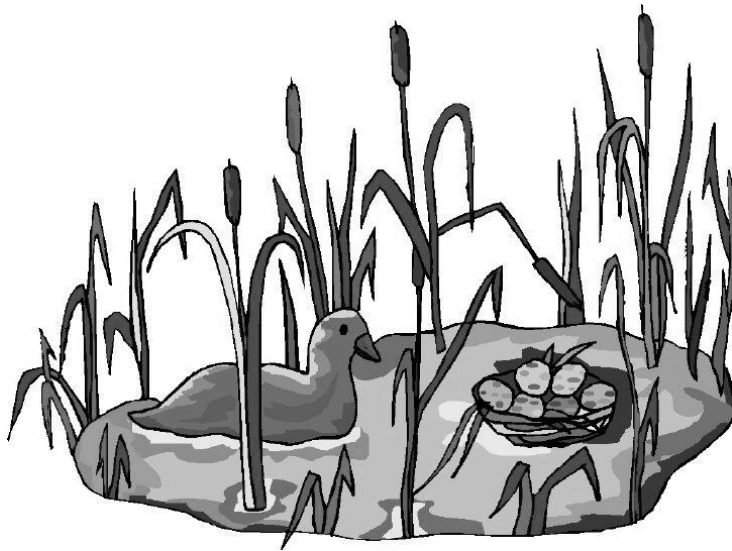
# The Ways to Conserve Bird Habitat
