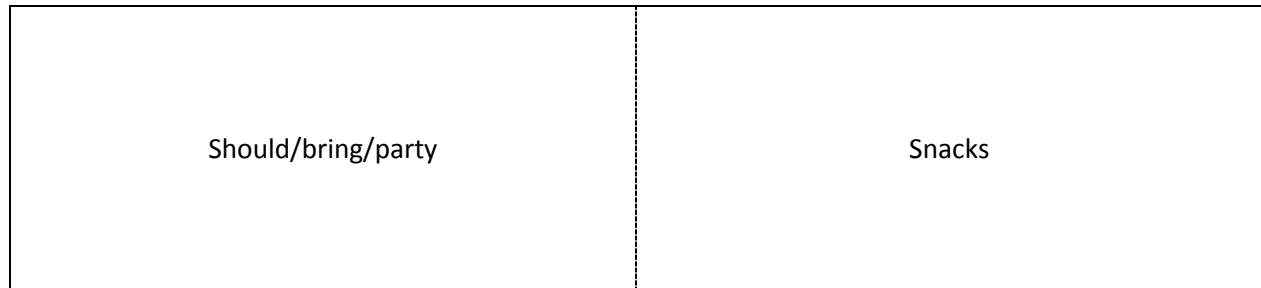


How to Use Drill Cards

These drill cards work well for practice activity, or engage activity in the classroom. To use the cards, cut out on the solid lines. You will have to cards together.

Pass out one card to each Ss. Even if there are two or more of the same card in the classroom, all Ss will have a chance to work with the cards.



Fold the cards on the center line.

Ss A makes a question statement with the card. Ss B can see the answer as A is asking the question.

A: What should I bring to the party?

B: You should bring snacks.

When finished Ss B asks the question on their card, and Ss A answers with the response.

When both Ss have asked the questions on the cards, Ss exchange cards. Now Ss can practice with a new question.

Have Ss mingle around the classroom asking and answering questions and exchanging cards as time permits.

One option, to move towards production is to repeat, but have Ss make up their own answers, not using the answer on the cards.

Following this activity, Ss should move to less controlled practice activity to prepare for a fluency or production activity.
